RED PLATFORM

RED Platform is an online website on which all kinds of instructional videos can be found that can help the digitally illiterate to find their way in this digital age.

Each partner has defined several categories relevant to the target group. For each category, each partner examines the public, social, health and other services that may be relevant to our target group. Each partner then produces an instruction video for a number of services that can guide our target group, in an understandable way, to make use of a particular service.

Red Platform is therefore an excellent tool that local organisations - such as the community, social services, human resources departments of companies / sheltered workshops, etc. - can use to support their target group. They can inform their target group about their existence so that they can work independently with the available instruction videos. This ensures an inclusive approach to break through digital illiteracy for our target group and get them along into this digital age.

These instructional videos are available for local organisations in Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Italy, the Netherlands, Slovenia, Spain and Belgium.






RED PLATFORM APPROACH

RED Platform is an online website on which the instruction videos per partner country and per category are made available to the target group.



The instructional videos are made with the Camtasia programme.

Camtasia enables the user to provide the videos with all kinds of handy animations that will provide the necessary guidance to our target group.




The instruction videos are then placed on the Xerte web platform.

Xerte is a free programme that helps teachers to design and put teaching materials online, without the need for extensive knowledge of programming languages. Originally started by the



University of Nottingham, it is currently part of the Apereo Foundation.

By using the instructional videos together with the Xerte platform, it is possible to provide additional guidance for our target group. Xerte makes it possible to automatically pause the instructional videos at certain times and provide them with additional information.


By using all technologies - RED Platform, instructional videos via Camtasia and Xerte - together, it is possible to obtain a split-screen result in which an instructional video will be shown on the left half of the screen, which will be paused automatically at appropriate times, while on the right half of the screen the user can carry out the instructions himself.

This ensures optimal but independent guidance for the people in the target group.




RED PLATFORM AN EXAMPLE

On the RED Platform, a user from the target group selects a topic within one of the categories for which he requires the necessary guidance.




The RED Platform ensures that Xerte is opened on the left half of the user's screen. The Xerte screen contains the instructional video, created in Camtasia, and underneath the instructional video there are additional guidelines for the user.



The instructional video will guide the user in filling in certain data on the website of a social institution. This website will open automatically on the right half of the screen of the user.

At certain defined moments, the instruction video will pause, and the user will be able to apply what he has just seen in practice.



In this way, the target group can be guided in an optimal way to start working independently in a digital world.
